less familiar world of contemporary Chinese ceramic sculpture. The dominant interest of Chinese work most often explores social issues and human relationships. Japanese work typically is concerned with the aesthetics of form, texture, color, materials, and the effect of time and kiln conditions. Both great artistic achievements are complementary, and together they give us a broader view of the glory of ceramics.

Beatrice L. Chang has been Director of Dai Ichi Arts, Ltd. in New York City for 17 years. She is the co-author of *Fired with Passion: Contemporary Japanese Ceramics*. She is also a frequent lecturer on the subject, and independent curator. For over 17 years, Beatrice Chang has studied and acquired Japanese ceramics, from fine contemporary works to rare and antique examples from the full range of Japan's ceramic production. Dai Ichi Arts, Ltd., is known for Ms. Chang's discernment in seeking out and discovering

prominent and promising Japanese ceramic artists of today. Among the outstanding artists represented by the gallery are Suehara Fukami, Yasuo Hayashi, Suzuki Goro, Koike Shoko, Kosuke Kaneshige, Yuriko Matsuda, Harumi Nakashima, Kato Tsubusa, Higashida Shigemasa and many others. Ms. Chang, who speaks and reads Japanese, travels frequently to Japan to keep abreast of new trends in ceramics and to seek out exceptional examples of ceramic art. Lately, Beatrice Chang became a pioneer in representing the contemporary Chinese ceramics outside of China.

Articles about the gallery and Ms. Chang's championship of Japanese and Chinese ceramics have appeared in publications such as *Art & Antiques*, *Asian Art Newspaper*, *Ceramics: Art and Perception*, *House & Garden*, *Orientations*, *The New York Times* and *The Wall Street Journal*. In addition to her expertise in Japanese and Chinese ceramics, Ms. Chang is also an accomplished calligrapher.
